Professor Lee Burns is a Professor in Taxation Law at the University of Sydney, specialising in international and comparative tax law. He was a major contributor to the leading comparative tax work - *Tax Law Design and Drafting*, and is also the author of *Controlled Foreign Companies: Taxation of Foreign Income*.

Professor Burns teaches a number of specialised taxation law subjects including Comparative International Taxation, Tax Law in the Asia and Pacific Region, and Taxation of Controlled Foreign Companies, Foreign Investment Funds and Transferor Trusts

Professor Burns has experience working with the IMF providing technical assistance to developing and transition countries on the design of their tax laws. He has presented papers at the Asian Development Bank Institute's annual international tax conference and taught in training workshops for tax administrators under projects funded by aid agencies.
